

Dear Safety Patrol applicants:

Safety patrol is now open for positions for next school year. Training will take place the month of May with new students starting the schedule in June.

Applications will be due Friday, April 27th.

There will be a mandatory meeting with Mrs Archuleta in the third grade pod during lunch time on Tuesday, May 1st.

Students will need to come to a training from 3:30-4:00 on Wednesday, May 2nd in Mrs Schubert's room. You will need to have a ride home at 4:00 that day.

To be on patrol you must:

- Be available every day during your scheduled time, either 8:35-9:05 in the morning or 3:20-3:45 in the afternoon. You will need to arrive at school early or leave late. Transportation must be provided, unless you walk to and from school.
- If you have activities that will not let you do your job, then do not sign up for patrol.
- Patrol takes priority before any clubs you sign up for. Patrol first, clubs second. All clubs will let you do your patrol job, then join in, or leave early in the morning.
- If you have a conflict due to an appointment before or after school, that is fine. But you need to let Miss Amy or Miss Sandie know so they can find someone to do your job.
- If you are sick and on patrol, please have your parent call the school to let them know you will not be there to do your job.
